Uniform Policy

In choosing St Nicholas CE Primary school for your child, you are agreeing to abide to its uniform and appearance policy. We firmly believe in the value of a school uniform. It generates a sense of pride and belonging, sets the tone of the school and is a great leveler, being the same for everyone.

Our school sweatshirts, fleeces and PE shirts which have the school logo must be purchased from **Midsomer Sports and Camping** (77 High Street, Midsomer Norton).

Girls

- Blue sweatshirt or sweatshirt cardigan with school logo
- Navy Blue polo shirt (school logo optional)
- Dark grey or black trousers/skirt/pinafore (no jogging bottoms, leggings or any type of jeans). **Skirts and pinafores MUST sit on or below the knee, but not be longer than mid-calf.**
- Flat black sensible shoes/black trainers
- White or navy socks or grey or navy tights
- Plain dark slides, navy blue or black scrunchies, hair bands or ribbons
- Navy Fleece with school logo (optional) **to be worn as a coat only**

For Summer (optional):

- Pale blue or navy checked dress. The dress **MUST sit on or below the knee, but not be longer than mid-calf.**
- Navy blue shorts (knee length straight style not pedal pushers or cycling shorts or denim)
- Navy blue baseball cap

Boys

- Blue sweatshirt with school logo
- Navy Blue polo shirt (school logo optional)
- Dark grey/ black trousers (no jogging bottoms or jeans please)
- Flat black sensible shoes or black trainers (no coloured trainers or canvas pumps or daps please)
- Plain black/ grey socks
- Navy Fleece with school logo (optional) **to be worn as a coat only**

For Summer (optional):

- Grey or navy blue shorts (knee length straight style not bermudas or cycling shorts or denim or sweatshirt material)
- Navy blue baseball cap

PE Kit (all children)

PE kit is to be kept in a named bag.

- Turquoise T shirt with school logo
- Navy shorts
- Trainers (non-marking soles)
- White socks
- Plain navy tracksuit bottoms (optional)

Book Bags

All children must have a school book-bag. The first one is supplied by school but any further bags must be purchased from the school office. The school book bag is the only bag permitted at school.

Earrings, Jewellery, Hairstyles, Nail Polish and Tattoos (These rules apply to girls and boys.)

Children may wear a wristwatch but are not permitted to wear necklaces, charity wristbands or bracelets of any description. Smart watches e.g. that can connect to the internet, send messages, take photos or record sound are not permitted.

In the interests of health and safety, we prefer the children not to wear earrings, but if they do, one pair of simple, plain studs may be worn in the ear lobe only, one in each ear. These must be removed or taped up for PE.

Children are not allowed to have extreme hair styles. For example: mohicans, beaded hair extensions, patterns shaved into the hair line, extremes of different lengths (eg long top hair with shaved sides or shaved undercuts) dyed hair and highlighted hair. For health and safety reasons hair below shoulder length should be tied back and long fringes clipped back (boys and girls).

Children must not wear nail polish, false nails, make up or tattoos.

Art Shirts, Wellingtons and Waterproof Coats

All children in KS2 must have an old t-shirt or shirt to wear for Art and DT. All children should have a pair of wellingtons and a waterproof coat for nature walks, wet days and playtimes.

Water Bottles

All children will need a named water bottle which is to be kept in school.
