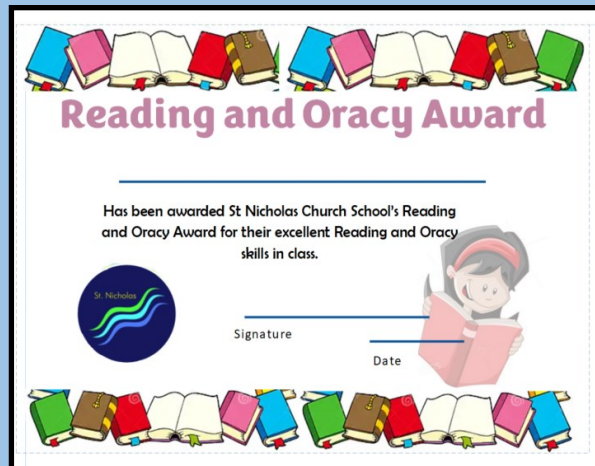

Parents can assist with both of these things by listening to their child read every night at home and by talking to them about the language and topic words that they are coming across in their learning. 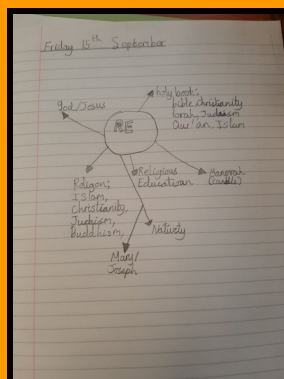
