## Reading

Your child needs to read at least 3 times a week. Every time they read their Reading Record needs to be filled in and signed. Reading books are kept for at least a week to develop fluency and confidence. An additional book will be sent home for you to read to your child and enjoy together. Encourage your child to talk about the pictures, storyline, and characters.

#### Sounds Folder

Each child has a sounds folder. Please practise these regularly at home and bring back everyday in the book bag.

#### **PE Kits**

Our PE lesson is on a Monday. Please make sure your child has their PE kit in school all week in case of any changes to timetable/additional sessions/ as well as our regular move a mile sessions. PE kits will be sent home every Friday to be washed and should be returned on Monday.

#### Pick up

Parents need to let your teacher know if you are being collected by somebody different at the end of the day. Please do this by communicating with a Wellow member of staff or messaging the office.

#### **Home/ School Communication**

Messages between parents/carers and teachers can be passed on at drop off and pick up times. It is useful to pass on messages about your child, for example if something is worrying them or if
