This trip, although during the school day, entails extra costs. In line with our charging and remissions policy we are asking parents to make a voluntary contribution of £21.16 to pay for their child. No pupil will be prevented from taking part because parents cannot make a contribution. However, If insufficient funds are collected, we will have no choice but to cancel the trip.

When making charges for trips the charge will be based on actual costs, divided by the total number of pupils taking part. There will be no levy on those who can pay to support those who can't or don't pay. Unfortunately, as the cost of the trip is based on a per pupil basis refunds will not be possible if your child does not attend the trip.

<u>Timings</u>

What To Wear

We will be outside for most of the day so they will need either a coat or sunhat depending on the predicted weather for that day. Please apply suncream in the morning if sunny weather is predicted.

Food and Drink

• Your child will need to bring a packed lunch with enough food for the day, and their school drinks bottle. This should be stored in a school bag or rucksack that they will be responsible for carrying around with them. Children who receive free school meals will have a lunch provided but please bring your drinks bottle. We will have a small snack upon arrival so please include some fruit for this time.

Medicines

• If your child is travel sick and takes medication, please can they take this before they come to school. If they will need a second dose for the journey home please give it to Ms Hinchliff, in a named envelope in the original packaging.

• If your child has an inhaler, they must have it with them for the trip. They will not be allowed to go without it.

• All other medicines will be carried by the adults present.
